What do you need to bring with you in order to file the FAFSA?

PRIOR to the January 16th session:

- Student and parent should apply for your FSA ID at fsaid.ed.gov. FSA IDs are required to sign the FAFSA.

Students and their parents should bring:

- Your laptop
- 2017 Federal Tax Return or other income documentation
- Social Security number(s)
- Driver's license (if any)
- 2017 W-2 Forms or year-end pay stubs and other year-end records of money received
- 2017 untaxed income records, such as child support received and veterans noneducation benefits
- Current information on checking and savings account balances; stock, bond, and other investments; and business and farm assets
- Your alien registration card (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
